## New industrial park taking shape in Jane Lew

**JANE LEW** — Work is progressing on a private industrial park being developed just off Interstate 79 in Jane Lew, with one new tenant announced.

“We have broken ground for a 15,000-square-foot building for Access Midstream,” said Craig Phillips, developer of the 75-acre industrial park. “We have signed a lease with them.”

Construction also has begun on the roads for the park, which is located on Hacker’s Creek Road/Lewis 7 about a quarter mile from Interstate 79.

“We are in the process of applying for an Industrial Road Access Grant of up to \$400,000. It would be used to upgrade the entrance into the park,” Phillips said.

The grant fund would be used to widen the road and make a turn lane into the park, Lewis County Economic Development Director Mike Herron said.
